COLONEL TREVOR O. D. NOEL

Colonel Trevor O. D. Noel is currently the Director of Staff-Air at the Joint Force Headquarters Ohio Air National, Columbus Ohio.

Colonel Noel holds two Master of Science degrees, one in Strategic Studies and the other in Human Resource Management along with a Bachelor of Science in Geography. He was commissioned in December 1981 from Texas A&M University where he was a member of the Texas A&M Corps of Cadets. He completed Squadron Officer School in residence in 1989, Air Command and Staff College in seminar in 1998 and Air War College in residence in 2004.



Colonel Noel began his 30 year military career as a rated Active Duty Air Force officer. Upon completing, Under Graduate Navigator Training (UNT), Advance Navigator Training, Survival Training and Combat Crew Training his first flying assignment in 1984 was as a Navigator on the KC-135A in Strategic Air Command. Excelling as a navigator he successfully completed his instructor certification and was assigned as an Instructor Navigator in the 7th Air Refueling Squadron in 1988. Further broadening his instructor capabilities in 1989 he was selected as a Flight Commander and Academic Instructor at Squadron Officer School (SOS), Air University, Air Education & Training Command. Continuing to grow in experience he was selected as a Curriculum & Program Manager at SOS in 1991. He closed out his active duty career in 1992 and joined the Texas Air National Guard. Serving as a Traditional Guardsman in the 181st Airlift Squadron he cross trained as a Mission Navigator on the C-130H as well as holding the duties of Squadron Quality Officer. In 1996 he moved to the 136th Airlift Wing as a Wing Plans and Battle Staff Executive Officer while still flying as a Navigator. He was then selected as the Wing Installation Inspector General in 1999 serving in that role until he was selected and attended Senior Service School, Air War College in residence in 2003. Upon graduation from AWC in 2004 he served a short tour at the USAF Counterproliferation Center at Maxwell AFB followed by a two year state side deployment to the Tanker Airlift Control Center (TACC) Air Mobility Command HQ, Scott AFB. Col Noel was then hired as the Deputy Mission Support Commander at the 136th Airlift Wing and served in that capacity for two and a half years until he was selected as the Mission Support Group Commander, 180th Fighter Wing, Ohio Air National Guard, located at Toledo Express Airport, Swanton, Ohio. He currently serves as the Director of Staff-Air, Ohio Air National Guard at the Joint Force Headquarters Ohio National Guard.
