Colonel Todd Audet is the Commander of the 200th RED HORSE Squadron, Ohio. The Squadron provides a self-sufficient mobile engineer and heavy construction capability for Combatant Commanders and the Governor of Ohio. His responsibility is to organize, train, and equip a 404 person unit that is ready to deploy worldwide within 72 hours of notification and operate in austere environments.

As a civilian, he serves as the Ohio Department of Transportation's District 2 Deputy Director, where he oversees overall operations including planning, design, construction and maintenance for the transportation needs of 8 counties in Northwest Ohio.



Colonel Audet has participated in numerous stateside and overseas deployments to include New Horizons, Silver Flag, Noble Eagle, Enduring Freedom, and Ohio's State Partnership program with Serbia.

Colonel Audet enlisted in the Air National Guard, 180th Civil Engineering Squadron, located in Swanton, Ohio in April 1985. He was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant at the Academy of Military Science, McGee Tyson, Tennessee, August 1990. He has over 26 years of combined enlisted/officer experience in the military and 20 years' experience as an engineer in government and the private sector.
